To All Bidders:

This addendum amends or supplements the original specifications and related documents for this project. Please include a copy of this addendum with your bid submission to prove receipt of the addendum and its terms.

Project Questions and Clarifications:

1. The "Notice to Contractors" and "Limited Notice to Proceed" states project start is April 1 and completion is Sept 3, a duration of 156 days; the "Information to Bidders" item 11 states that the contract will be complete in 90 days. Please clarify.
Response: The bid documents prevail this the completion date is September 3, 2010 a duration of 90 days.
2. The Site Furnishings Schedule includes the sculpture "S1". Please confirm that the cost of the sculpture is not to be included in the Bid Schedule (as part of line # 64).
Response: The sculpture will be supplied and installed by 'others'.
3. Sheet 1/7 QUANTITY NOTES: item 1 says "the contractor is responsible for determining the bid quantities". Please confirm the contractor is to bid the predetermined bid quantities as shown on the Bid Schedule.
Response: The quantities provided are to be used in making the final bid. Any concerns on accuracy should have been submitted in writing,
4. I am unclear about testing and/or inspecting services. GENERAL CONDITIONS items 7.2 and 7.3 would seem to say if testing/inspection is shown in the documents then the contractor is to provide, if not, city to provide.

Therefore, by not finding any reference to soil compaction, concrete testing, masonry testing, or steel testing in the documents that 7.2 would then apply and that testing is by the city. Please confirm testing responsibilities.

Response: The City has an inspection testing firm under contract. If there are required certifications required by the manufacture those certifications are the responsibility of the contractor.

5. In reference to the "within 5% of the non-local (bid)". In order to apply this factor from which of the two bids is the 5% calculated? If 5% of the greater bid is taken off it could overtake the low bid whereas if 5% of the low bid was added it would not reach that greater bid's amount.

Response: Any local prime contractor must be within 5 % of the low bid.

6. Sheet 2/7 item 10 says "contractor to obtain all permits". General Condition article 10.3 says "permanent structure permits by owner". Article 4.2 says "plans govern over specs". But the plans have the specifications in them. Is item 10 on sheet 2/7 "on the plans" or "in the spec"? Please clarify whether the contractor or the owner purchases building permit. Related, who is responsible for the ¼" water capacity charge and meter costs?

Response: All permit and fees are the responsibility of the contractor.

Below is an estimate of necessary fees:

7. Please provide a specification for the water feature waterproofing.

Response: Rubberized water stop at joint locations as specified on drawings, caulk with poly urethane, one coat pool paint primer (poxoprime) and two coats color: "black" epoxy pool paint (poxolon). Supplier: Kelley Technical coatings. 1445 South 15 St. Louisville, KY. 40210. 800-458-2842 OR EQUAL.

8. What are the weights of each artifact piece from the World Trade Center towers?
RESPONSE: We don't have an exact weight, but below are the estimated weights of each metal artifact based on size and material

Item # G-0047: Approx. 8,500 pounds.

Item # I-0038: Approx. 4,000 pounds.

Item # C-0032: Approx. 1,000 pounds.

Total Approx. weight of load: 13,500 pounds

9. Are there any other specs that we need to base our bid on for this project other than those on sheet L9.00, L9.01 and L9.02?

Response: The only specifications are those in the plans and bid documents.

10. During the pre-bid meeting it was mentioned that any company residing in Hilliard will have a 5% match option. Would you consider changing that option if we can show that we are using local companies as our subcontractors and/or vendors?

Response: This only applies to the primary bid and the primary bidder must be within Hilliard City Limits.


11. Could you also provide another manufacturer for the Trellis? We have contacted FIBERTECH and they informed us that they are not bidding this project. They actually said that they do not perform that type of work.
